- 2. Sallie Salter led the group with prayer.
- 3. Robert Lewis referenced the recent Veteran's Day and had some words regarding Terrance MacMahon, former board member that passed away this year.

Secretary's Report:

- 1. Minutes from the 2018 Annual Meeting were distributed.
- 2. The report was reviewed.
- 3. Steve Phifer moved to accept the minutes.
- 4. Motion was seconded by Brian Lawrence.
- 5. The motion to approve the secretary's report passed

Treasurer's Report:

- 1. Chief Melinda Ward distributed financial reports and gave the Treasurer's Report.
 - a. Budget comparison for the year was presented
 - b. profit-loss report was reported
- 2. Tony Bello moved to approve treasurer's report, Steve Phifer seconded. Motion passed

Fire Department Report:

- 1. Chief Tony Matthews reported
- 2. 36 active members, 4 driver operators m-f,
- 3. 364 calls for 2018.
 - a. 237 Fire related calls.
 - b. 127 ems assists/smoke alarms/etc.
 - c. 86 mutual aid given
 - d. 33 mutual aid received.
- 4. Response Time: 3.47 seconds dispatch in route. 10.05 minutes on scene from dispatch
- 5. 268 calls for 2019.
- 6. ISO reclassification from class 7 to class 5 (improved). This will reflect in community homeowner's insurance.
- 7. FD has acquired a boat for water rescue calls.
- 8. All trucks are in good shape
- 9. Oct. 18, fire prevention class for Bogue Sound Elementary was a success
- 10. Christmas party December 7.
- 11. Annual Santa Claus Ride December 14.
- 12. Need to start replacing air packs.
- 13. Process for creating first responder program to work with EMS. Provide quicker access for calls

1. Chief Melinda Ward reported the need for paramedics has been answered.

- 1. Four applicants for a full time medic.
- 2. 31 total on paid staff. Medics are in shortage across the country
- 3. 782 calls ran last year. Dispatched to 810
- 4. Predicted to be over 800 this year.
- 5. EMS stays on scene to perform CPR, no longer to transport for CPR. Improvements have been noticed.
- 6. Drugs can now be administered.
- 7. If a true heart attack is diagnosed, transport to Carolina East will be provided. EKG is now available for mobile devices for quicker response during transportation. Funded by a grant from Carolina East Medical Center.
- 8. EMS does offer CPR classes if needed.
- 9. EMS is now under DHHS not NCDOT anymore. It is expanding and growing.
- 10. New director for the state, Dr. Winslow. NC is leading the nation in performance.

Building and Grounds Report:

- 1. Mark Rippeth reported
 - a. HVAC at community building replaced and one more may need to be repaired
 - b. Community Building has a new floor.
 - c. Generator is working at FD, out of power one day last week,
