 - d. Air packs are not going out of date. Hydrostatic test expires on the bottles. Expired bottles should not be used. Looking to replace 10 this year (Half of what is currently owned). This will take care of two engines. County reserves will be funding this. \$30-40k should be added by the end of the year. Tony will bring to the board purchasing vs. leasing. 10 air packs and 20 bottles Total.

EMS Report:

- 1. Chief Melinda Ward reported.
 - a. Hired a full time medic. While waiting for approval after county testing (10 days), she took on another job.
 - b. Hoping to hire a few new medics, but there is a shortage across the state.
 - c. May 16, EMS week is celebrated with a dinner open to the board at the station. 7:00pm.

Building and Grounds Report:

 - a. Air conditioner went out upstairs. Replaced capacitor. A quote for maintenance plan for EMS will be provided.
