Fire Department Report: Chief Tony Matthews Reported

- 1. Fire Department Report:
 - a. Trucks:
 - i. Engine 1 went in for warranty repairs. Will be returning to the shop to fix a couple of minor issues when parts come in. No issues with other trucks.
 - b. Pump test was completed today and SCBA flow testing is next Friday the 22nd
 - c. Hose Testing to start next week.
 - d. October Activities:
 - i. Fire Prevention at Bogue Sound Elementary.
 - ii. Assisted Camp Albemarle with their annual mud run.
 - iii. Participated in a county wide water shuttle drill for ISO purposes.
 - iv. We have been asked to help Camp Albemarle with their Halloween event.
 - e. Haz-Mat classes starting at the station Next Monday and running for two weeks.
 - f. Meeting with neighboring chiefs redoing our mutual aid agreements.
 - g. Number of year-to-date calls have increased by 50 over last year.

EMS Report: Chief Melinda Ward Reported

- 1. EMS Report
 - a. EMS is down to one ambulance until vehicles get back from the shop.
 - b. The new stretcher is being moved out of EMS 6 and set up in EMS 1.
 - c. New lettering and decaling on New EMS 1.
 - d. B.O.D. voted to re-number Ambulances back to 1 and 2.

- e. We have had 657 calls for the year so far. a slight increase for this year.
- f. COVID is still around strong.
- g. Flu season is starting, so please get your flu shot.
- h. We are beginning our fundraiser for the year.
 - i. Pictures will be taken November 20, 2021, unsure of time yet.

- 1. Building and Grounds Committee
 - a. Steve Phifer, Chair:
 - i. Elite AC Solutions Quotes have been distributed.
 - ii. Sink hole at the community playground needs to be addressed.
 - iii. The light over the entry door is out and needs to be replaced.
- 2. Community Services Committee (Community Building/Cemetery)
 - a. <u>Sallie Salter</u>, Chair:
 - i. Community Building Rentals are slowing down.
 - ii. Details in the works for the fall festival.
 - 1. Pig and water donated.
 - 2. Coleslaw, baked beans, and hushpuppies need to be secured.
 - 3. Cakes are being made for cakewalk.
 - 4. Working on games and prizes.
 - 5. There will be a 50/50 drawing and possibly a couple of auction items.
- 3. Bylaws Committee
 - a. Robert Lewis, Chair:
 - i. Final review of the Bylaws and Policy and procedures.
 - 1. Dusty recommended that Article VI simply state "Shall extend from July 1 to June 30th."
 - 2. Article 7 section 7 strike-out everything after the word "bylaws."
 - 3. Each Article will be voted on individually at the Annual Meeting. If all Article amendments are approved, the Policy and procedures will automatically be implemented according to the language in the amendments.
- 4. Ways and Means Committee
 - a. Missy Rhodes, Chair:

 - c. Tony Bello did say that the grant application for Big Rock has been submitted for playground equipment. Seems very promising per the phone call Tony had with the Big Rock representative who had some questions.

- 3. The washed-out spillways at the Fire Department are still not repaired and quotes are needed.
- 4. Elite AC Quotes reviewed for approval.

 - c. Motion Passed.
- 5. Trash Pickup:
 - a. Richards Sanitation quoted dumpster pickup every two weeks for \$90.00 to \$100.00 a month.
 - b. Steve Phifer questioned whether or not to switch services.

- c. If the association stays with the current contract, under the name of EMS, we will need to have a monthly invoice submitted by EMS to the association each month for payment.
- d. GFL contract requires notification of service cancellation 120 days before the end of the contract, or the contract renews automatically. It is cheaper to stay with GFL for \$120.00 a month. The board agrees that no changes are needed at this time.
- 6. We are still in dispute with Mallard gas over a delinquent bill for services that were not rendered.
